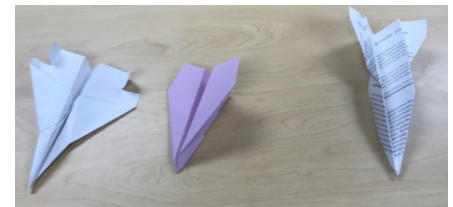
Dear St. Michael Families and Friends,

It is finally beginning to feel like and look like Autumn. There are so many fun activities to do around town — I hope you are able to schedule some time to enjoy the beautiful weather.

In honor of the memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7th, our Junior High students, with help from our Kindergarteners led us in praying the Living Rosary.

There is some cool science happening here at St. Michael! In the Junior High, the students have been making paper airplanes, and then flying them in the hallway. The students are learning about force and velocity. They are also experimenting with type of paper used and the style of the airplane. Our second graders are joining the water bottle flipping craze. They are learning how to collect and record data while they toss a plastic water bottle in the air. The students are replacing water with candy corn. Our wonderful teachers are so creative and enjoy making learning FUN!



Tomorrow our students in Grades K-5 will see a performance, *Showdown At The Resource Ranch*, provided by Duke Energy. They sent enough materials for the entire school. 6. Find Organization: Enter our organization code **UF834**, or search for "**St. Michael Church**" (verify it has our Spinner Ave address).
7. Select "**Enroll**".
8. Within 7-10 days you will see a note at the bottom of your Kroger receipt confirming your registration.
