Our Facilities

St. Michael Parish School has a rich history. Our school campus houses three buildings; each has a distinct character. Our classrooms provide a warm and friendly learning environment for your child. Our library/media

center provides accessibility to the Accelerated Reader® program, and we also have a computer/technology lab with a 1:1 student-to-computer ratio. We are also proud of our art room, as well as our music room, which is equipped with a variety of musical instruments. We are fortunate to have an Assembly Hall, which hosts indoor physical education classes, as well as special performances and programs throughout the school year. All of our facilities are air-conditioned.

Our church is one of the most beautiful pieces of architecture on our campus, and provides us with a wonderful place of community and spiritual renewal.

Our Catholic Identity

While our student body is comprised primarily of children from the Roman Catholic faith, we welcome students from other faith traditions. All students participate in weekly Mass and various other prayer experiences including school prayer services, classroom prayer, sacramental preparation, and community service. Our second grade students receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation in December, and make their First Communion in the spring. Our eighth grade students prepare for and are con-firmed in the spring.

This very popular program provides opportunities for homework completion, developing friendships, and after-school recreation. This program is available for students in kindergarten through sixth grade.
