Dear Soon-to-Be 4th Grade Parent,

As part of the language arts curriculum at St. Michael School, your child is required to read during the summer months. He or she will need to read a minimum of three books (one per month) written at an appropriate grade level for your child. All three books must be chapter books. Upon completing each book, your child will need to fill out a line on the reading log on the back of this page. For each book, the title and author of the book need to be recorded as well as the answer to one of the comprehension questions at the bottom of the page. The answer to the comprehension question must be a complete sentence with correct capitalization and punctuation. During the first week of school, your child will need to turn in the reading log with at least three entries to me, the 4th grade language arts teacher.

Of course I would encourage your child to read many books over the summer months, but only three are required. He or she can receive extra credit for reading more than three chapter books by filling out more lines on the reading log. I hope that you will promote daily reading with your child(ren) during the summer vacation. Thanks for your cooperation.
